- Our grants are intended for projects 9-12 months in duration, implemented between Q4 2026 and Q4 2027. The 9-12 month period can also be part of a multi-year project.
- Information should not be repeated throughout the form. Make sure you provide new and relevant information for each question
- We do not accept applications for projects that:
  - Are in the initial phase (the scoping / consulting stages, etc.)
  - Were previously submitted to the Eurofins Foundation but not selected for funding.
  - Are affiliated with any political or religious organisation or ideology.
  - Do not align with the objectives of the Eurofins Foundation.
  - Are incomplete (for example, mandatory documents are not provided on time)
  - Do not include sources for any data provided in the application (consider providing an annex with data sources)

### Application deadline:

The deadline for applications has been set at **1 September 2026 at 5 pm CEST (Belgium time zone)**. However, we strongly advise you to not wait for the deadline and to apply as soon as possible. We have modified our review process and will now be assessing applications on an ongoing rolling basis, and this review/selection process will stop once we've reached our annual budget limit. Depending on the applications received, this may be before our official deadline date has been reached. Please note, even with this change, all grant decisions will be communicated during the first half of December.

Provide the budget for the full duration of the project + for the period you are requesting a grant for (if different, and for maximum 1 year).
