SCIP is the database for information on Substances of Concern In articles as such or in complex objects (Products) established under the Waste Framework Directive (WFD). SCIP notification comes into force on January 5, 2021

Companies supplying articles on the EU market, containing **substances of very high concern (SVHCs)** included in the REACH candidate list, in concentrations over 0.1% weight by weight (w/w), will have to submit information on these articles to ECHA, as from 5 January 2021.

Automated SCIP submmission
