






CAMBODIA - Rice Cultivation Areas




CAMBODIA PADDY PRODUCTION





CAMBODIA: TYPE OF PADDY PR

1 Highland Rice Cultivation

This is a seasonal crop planted in June and July and harvested around November and December in the northern regions of Cambodia by the mountainous ethnic groups. The cultivation area is approximately 20,000 hectares, and most of the rice varieties grown are **organic**.

2 Deepwater Rice Cultivation

This seasonal crop is planted in May and harvested in November, primarily around the Great Lake (Tonle Sap). Around 22,000 hectares are currently cultivated. The height of the rice plant depends on the depth of the water. (**Organic rice**)

3 Seasonal Crop Group (Medium and Long Grain)

Jasmine rice is the main crop, grown with seasonal rainfall across more than 2.97 million hectares.

4 Non-Seasonal Crop Group

Most of the crops are fragrant and white rice varieties (OM, SKO, IR, SRO) and the cultivation of those varieties is based on the availability of the irrigation system. This covers over 0.84 million hectares.



Types of Rice Variety Production-2024

- **Seasonal Fragrant Rice (Jasmine Rice)**
 - Farmers typically grow jasmine rice varieties such as Pkha Rumdoul, Somali, and Pkha Malis around the Tonle Saparea.

Area: 867,328 ha | Yield: 2.98 t/ha | Total Production: 2.58 million tons

- Non-Seasonal Fragrant Rice
 - Farmers grow SKO and SRO varieties in areas equipped with irrigation systems.

Area: 326,346 ha | Yield: 3.989 t/ha | Total Production: 1.30 million tons

Non-Fragrant / Seasonal Rice (White Rice)

This is primarily grown for domestic consumption. Varieties include Neang Khun, Choul Sa, and other traditional types.

*Area: 919,765 ha | Yield: 3.12 t/ha | Total Production: 2.89 million tons

∧ Non-Fragrant / Non-Seasonal Rice (White Rice)

Most of these crops are imported varieties such as OM and IR.

Area: 1,702,804 ha | Yield: 4.19 t/ha | Total Production: 7.13 million tons

Sro Nge (SRO) - Locally Known as Wild Rice

- Developed by local breeders between 2018 and 2020.
- Characteristics are similar to Sen Kra-Ob (SKO) but less fragrant.
- Growth period: 75-80 days.
- Tolerant to climate change, requires less water, and resistant to diseases.







CAMBODIA PADDY & RICE EXPORT VOLUMES

WHAT ARE WE GOING TO FOCUS ON NEXT?

1 Improving Production Yield

The Cambodia Rice Federation (CRF) and the General Directorate of Agriculture, under the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF), support farmers in improving production yields by applying proper land leveling, controlling fertilizer and pesticide use, and using varieties that are tolerant to climate change.

2 Sustainable Rice Platform (SRP)

CRF and the General Directorate of Agriculture, under the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF), aim to scale up SRP production through coordination with the Cambodia SRP National Chapter.

3 Low-Carbon Rice

CRF will pilot low-carbon rice projects by applying the Alternate Wetting and Drying (AWD) method starting at the end of the year.

4 Organic Rice

CRF will collaborate with all relevant government ministries to develop GI (Geographical Indication) areas for organic rice, mainly in highland cultivation regions such as Preah Vihear, Mondulkiri, Ratanakiri, and Stung Treng provinces.
