Billing FAQ

Invoices are generated the next business day after the report is sent. Invoices are sent as a PDF attachment via email; if there is more than one invoice generated daily there will be multiple attachments to the transaction email. It is important that we have the correct billing email address to avoid delays in processing invoices. The left section of the chain of custody is reserved for customer information with a billing email section. Please feel free to contact us to update account information at your convenience. Statements are generated once per month at the customer's request; the invoices will be listed in date order. Payment can be in form of check, wire transfer, ACH or via credit card on our website.
