Thank you for your request for a scope revision in the Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program. Attached is your new Scope of Accreditation effective November 13, 2018.

The following change has been made to your laboratory scope:

The following parameter has been added in your laboratory scope based in part on recognition of NYELAP (NY State Dept. of Health Wadsworth Center). The parameter is in good standing status, based on the receipt of acceptable PT results and current Certificate and Scope of Accreditation from NY State Dept. of Health Wadsworth Center.

- *Asbestos by EPA 100.2_1994, in Drinking Water matrix.*

As a reminder, continued participation in the Ecology Lab Accreditation Program requires the lab to:

- Submit a renewal application and fees annually
- Report significant changes in facility, personnel, analytical methods, equipment, the lab's quality assurance (QA) manual or QA procedures as they occur
- Participate in proficiency testing studies semi-annually, with the following exception: For each parameter where all PT results were satisfactory, you are required to submit only one PT result over this next year, and in subsequent years, as long as the results are satisfactory.
